Number of Ski Areas Operating Per State During 2019/20 Season

There are ski areas operating in 37 U.S. states. Currently, New York leads with the most operating areas with 51, followed by Michigan's 40 ski areas, and Wisconsin and Colorado with 31. There were a total of 470 operating ski areas during the 2019/20 season, including four new or reopened areas: Big Snow American Dream, NJ (new); Teton Pass, MT; Woodward Park City, UT (new); Coppervale Ski Area, CA.
